

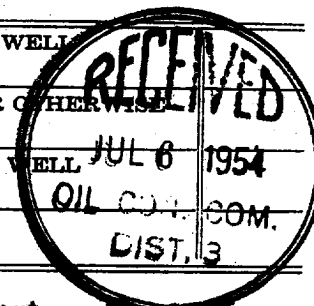
NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

June 28, 1954 - spudded well with rotary rig.

June 29, 1954 - Ran 4 joints (160 feet) of 9-5/8" new casing. Set at 172 feet. Cemented with 125 sacks cement, 2 sacks calceal. Plug down at 2:15 A.M.

June 30, 1954. - Started drilling plug at 2:15 a.m. Tested casing with 500 pounds pressure & no drop. O. K. to continue drilling.

Continued drilling with 8-3/4" bit.
