

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Skidded rig 13.15 feet to the North of Suter No. 1 Federal, which was located 1650 North and 1650 East, Sec. 13-32N-11W.
It is proposed to drill with rotary mud to the top of the Mesa Verde formation estimated to be at a depth of 4800 and thereafter drill with gas through the Mesa Verde to an estimated total depth of 5500. It is further proposed to shoot the entire Mesa Verde section with solidified nitroglycerine. Tentative casing program is as follows.

10 3/4" surface casing 180-250 cement with 150-250 sacks.

7" casing 4800 cement with 250-300 sacks.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
