DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded August 19, 1952. 10-3/4" cmt. at 218' with 125 sacks. Tested for 30 minutes with 500" pressure with no leaks. Cement Plug was drilled August 20, 1952, tested for 30 minutes with 500" pressure with no drop in pressure.
