28-7 Well. After running 7" casing the plug was pumped to 4750'. On July 20, 1953 the perforations in the Arutland formation were completed with 200 cut reg. cement. Break formation with 2000', maximum pressure 2000', final pressure 1600'. Reperforated perforations with 125 cut reg. cement. Break formation with 2000', maximum pressure 1600', final pressure 1600'. Drilled 2-1/2 in. cement in 7" casing to plug back to 2750'. Loss Wellbore perforated with same jet shots & holes per foot from 2750' to 2800' and from 2700' to 2750' 1.50 inches.
