FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools in the following manner:

1. Set surface casing - 9-5/8" at 150' with cement to surface.
2. To drill through the Pictured Cliffs and test Fruitland and Pictured Cliffs.
3. If commercial gas is found, to set 5 1/2" casing at 2900' with 200 sacks cement.
4. If not commercial, to drill to the Mesaverde at total depth 5996'.
5. To set casing - 7" O.D. at 5556' with 300 sacks regular cement.

Either productive formation will be shot with two quarts of S.N.G. per foot.

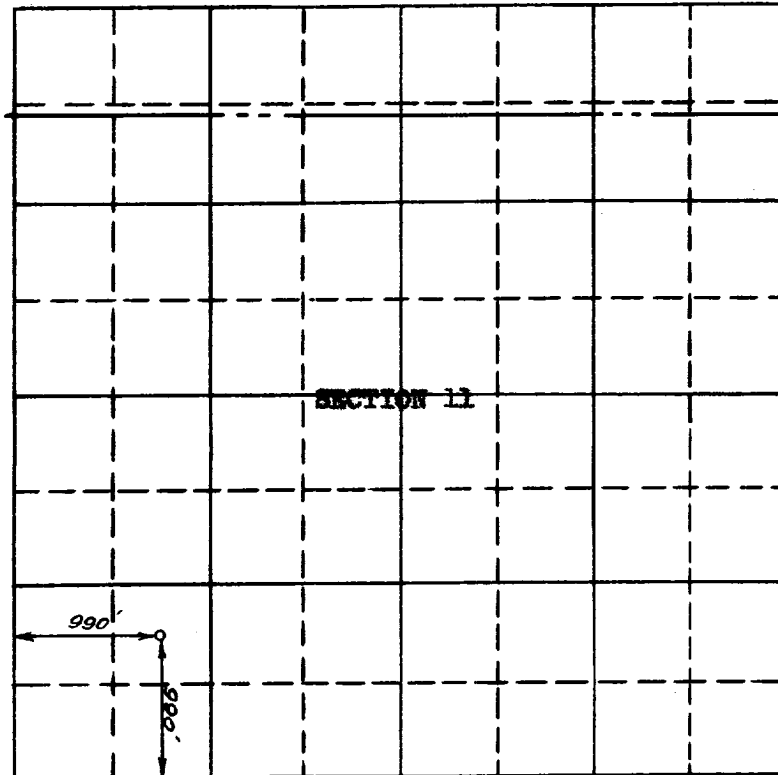

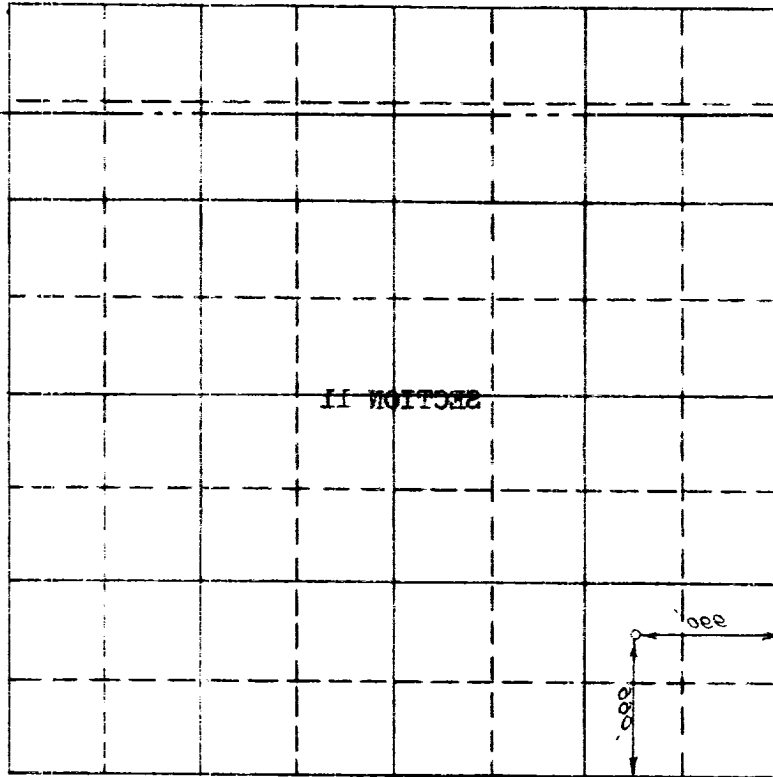
