



ORDER NO. MC-1558

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 22, 1964, for permission to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 26 located in Unit I of Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde

Now, on this 11th day of November, 1964, the Secretary-

- That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- That the proposed dual completion will not cause (4) waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 26 located in Unit I of Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
