Gentlemen:

The Greenbrier Oil Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit, in the South Half of Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, comprising 134.0 acres. In support of this request it submits the following information:

1. Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, is bordered on the North by the State of Colorado, and is what is known as a "short section". The Greenbrier Oil Company Waller Unit #1 well is located 890 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the West line of said section. This well was tied into the El Paso Natural Gas Company line on May 13, 1954.

2. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental section.

3. The entire unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.

4. A copy of this letter, sent by registered mail to all offset operators, will notify them of the intent to form such non-standard gas proration unit.

Greenbrier Oil Company respectfully requests consideration of this application under the provisions of Order #4-128-C, Rule 1(b), without notice and hearing, and approval of the subject non-standard

Gas Proportion Unit.
