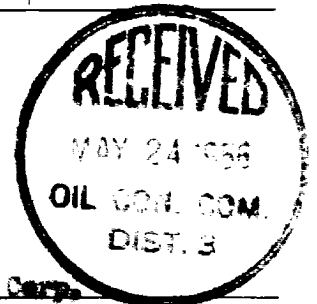

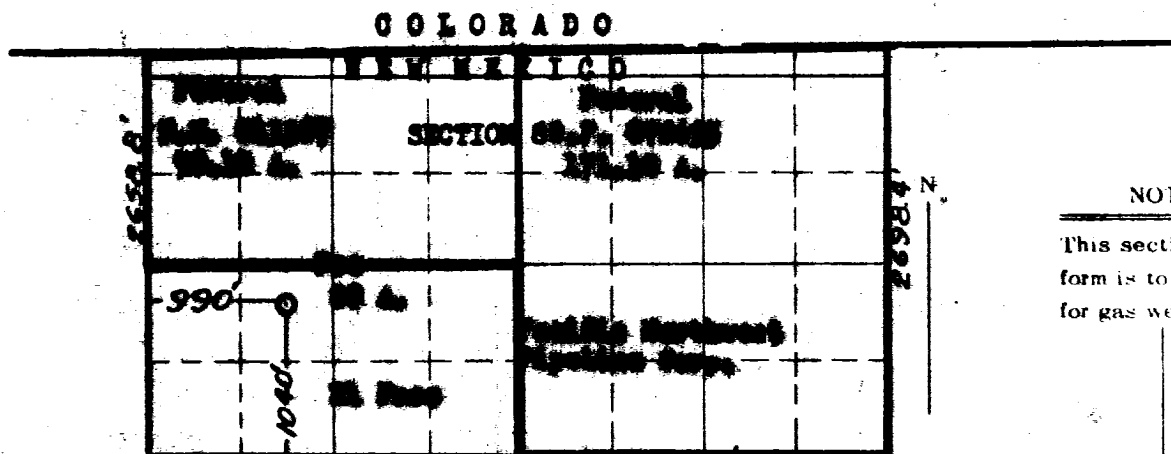
WELL LOCATION AND/OR EXPLORATION PLAT
