Reference is made to your application for approval of a 333.60 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 32 North, Range 11 West, NMPM
All of Fractional Section 12

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Suter-Federal Well No. 2-X, located 1750 feet from the South line and 1750 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (b)-4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-D, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 333.60 acres.

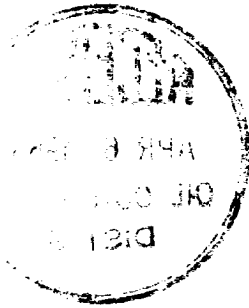
