The Pubco, et al, #1 Decker well, located 1850 feet from the South line and 1850 feet from the West line of Section 7, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, was completed as a gas well on March 31, 1954, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company line on June 4, 1954.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 332.27 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
