DETAILS OF WORK

Standard Oil Company of Texas a division of California Oil Company hereby gives notice of intention to drill the subject well to a total depth of approximately 8300' with rotary tools. A 17 1/2" hole will be drilled to approximately 60' where 13 3/8" O. D., 48#, H-40, ST&C new casing will be cemented with cement to surface. A 12 1/4" hole will be drilled to approximately 850' where 9 5/8" O.D., 36#, J-55, ST&C new casing will be cemented with approximately 350 sks. An 8 3/4" hole will be drilled to approximately 4000'. Should hole trouble be encountered an intermediate string of new casing will be cemented at approximately 4000' with approximately 400 sks. A 6 3/4" hole will be drilled to a total depth of 8300', if commercial production is indicated 4 1/2" O.D., 9.5# and 11.6#, J-55, ST&C new casing will be cemented at approximately 8300' with approximately 300 sks. Completion procedure will follow as warranted.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

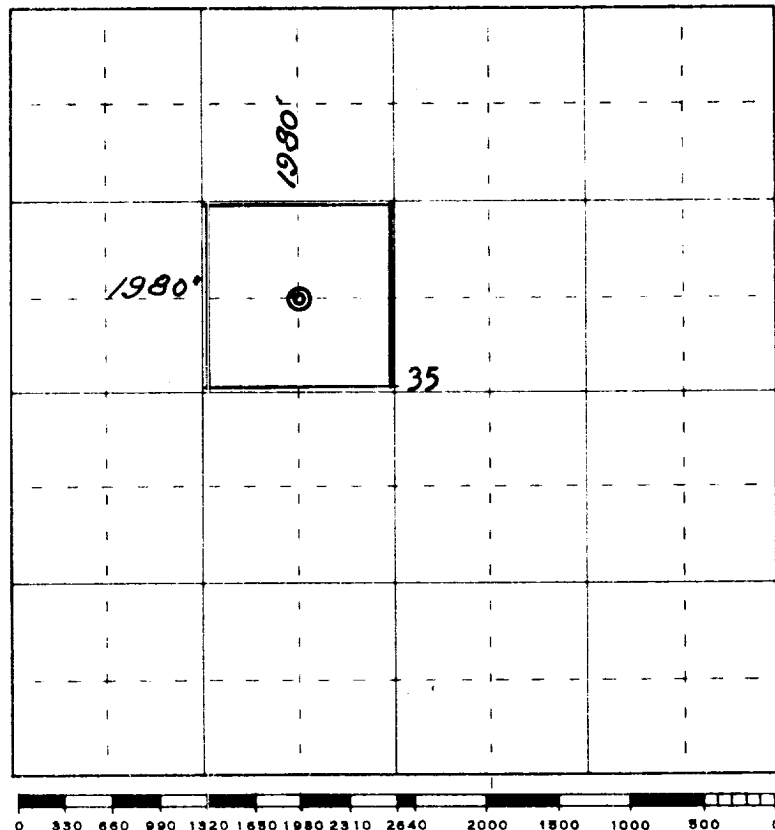
