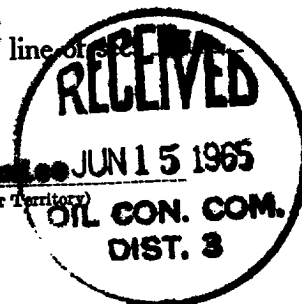

DETAILS OF WORK

On January 22, 1964 removed back pressure valve from tubing. Rigged up test equipment and conducted bottom hole pressure survey. Flowed 210 barrels oil and 60 barrels water in two days. Conducted bottom hole pressure survey. On January 31, 1964 opened well and flowed 374 barrels oil and 6 barrels water in five days. On potential test February 3, 1964, flowed 127 barrels oil, 49 AP1, 12/64 choke, T.P. 400 psi, GOR 1075, cut 0.5% H2O. Plan to continue testing well through February 11, 1964 and conduct bottom hole pressure survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

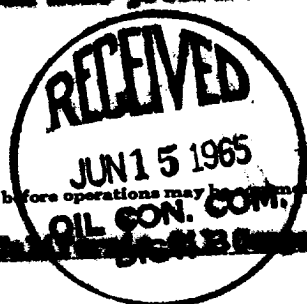
