DETAILS OF WORK

Set bridge plug on wireline at 7020'. Ran tubing and packer to 6917'. Nipped up tree. Tested bridge plug to 3000 psi, O.K. Perforated selectively interval 6948-6979 with 11 shots. Acidized perforations 6948-6979 with 1000 gallons. Grilled and flowed 204 PW and 6 IHO in 3 days. Shut well in. On 4-19-64, removed tree, installed BOP. Pulled packer and tubing. Set cement retainer at 6917'. Spurred perforations 6948-6979 with 80 cu. cement. On 4-20-64. Drilled out cement 6940-7020'. Tested squeeze to 2000 psi, O.K. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and packer. Set packer at 6946'. Removed BOP, nipped up tree. Perforated 6940-6956' with 5 shots. Acidized perforations with 500 gallons. Recovered 85 barrels salt water, no oil in 3 days. Shut well in and released pulling unit 4-27-64.
