

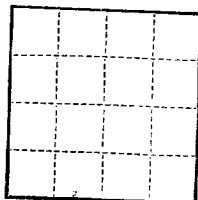

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5433 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

The above well was spudded on 12/15/59. 8 5/8" csg. was set at 142 ft. with 100 sacks cement. Cement was circulated to surface. The pipe was tested after 24 Hr. with 1000# pressure. No leaks were found. A 7 7/8" hole was drilled to 4693 ft. 5 1/2" csg. was cemented at that point with 200 sacks cement in two stages. Stage collar was at 3540'. After 30 hours the casing was tested above and below the DV tool with 1500# pressure. No leaks were found. A 4 3/4" hole was then drilled to a TD of 4796. A 4" flush joint slotted liner was then set in the interval 4796-4670.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
