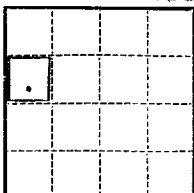

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Moved in, rigged up pulling unit. Packed rods, pump and tubing.
2. Run and set retrievable bridge plug at 2020 feet. Tested plug to 2000 psi, OK.
3. Run logs and perforated selected, 3760-80, 3822-32, 3900-4000 ft. with 1 jet per foot.
4. Fracture treated perforations with 90,000 gallons lease crude, 2500 pounds of sand and ball sealers.
5. Checked well bore for filling.
6. Run tubing, pump and rods. Placed on production 10:15 A.M., May 8, 1963.
7. Now conducting production test. Last 1510 barrels load oil.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
