

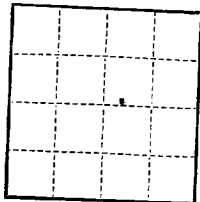

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded well on 6-13-60. Set 8 5/8" casing at 136' with 125 sacks cement.
Circulated 15 sacks. BOC 24 hours and tested casing with 1000 PSI water pressure, and found no leaks. Presently drilling ahead at 3150'.
