DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded well on November 28, 1959. Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 216' and reamed to 12-1/4". 8-5/8" casing was set at 216' with 160 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop.
