

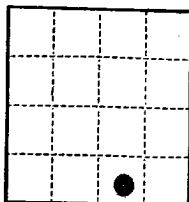

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded at 5:15 P.M., March 31, 1960.

Drilled 11" hole to 124' and cemented 116' of 8-3/8" O.D. casing at 124' with 190 sacks of cement. Cement circulated.

Drilled 6-3/4" hole to 1705' and cemented 1698' of 4-1/2" O.D. casing at 1705' with 100 sacks of cement. Cement circulated. Tested casing with 1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Tested O.K.
