

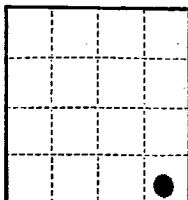

DETAILS OF WORK

**Spudded at 4:00 A.M., January 21, 1960.**

**Drilled 11" hole to 104' and cemented 86' of 8-3/8" O.D. casing at 94' with 100 sacks of cement. Cement circulated.**

**Drilled 6-1/4" hole to 1634' and cemented 1674' of 4-1/2" O.D. casing at 1602' with 100 sacks of cement. Top of cement 900'. Tested casing with 1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Tested O.K.**
