It is proposed to shut in side Upper Permian Injection well as part of a program to determine effectiveness of water injection in the east corner of the Horseshoe Gallup Field. It is proposed to shut in about 20 wells in this area and thereafter their injection rates to wells near the corner of the field. The shut area is an area of relatively poor coal development. It is expected that this test will last about four months; however, if any adverse effects on oil production are noted, injection will be resumed immediately.
