ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1745, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on December 7, 1970, for permission to expand its Horseshoe Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, by the drilling of an additional injection well to be located 1050 feet from the North and East lines of Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 17 West, NMPM.

NOW, on this 27th day of December, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1745.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1745.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Navajo "M" Well No. 7 located 1050 feet from the North Line and 1050 feet from the East line of Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 17 West, NMPM. Said well to be completed in the manner described in the application dated December 3, 1970.
