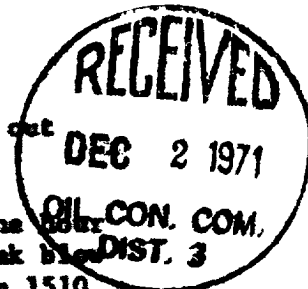

The Ute Mountain Tribal "D" No. 4 was drill stem tested as follows:

DST No. 1 3110-3267'. Recovered 1400' formation water, 210' mud cut water, 200' of drilling mud. No gas show.

Tool open 13 minutes with weak blow and no gas to surface. SI one then tool opened one hour with weak blow decreasing to a very weak blow with no gas. Tool then closed one hour. Hydrostatic pressure in 1510 psi, 13 minute IFP 239, 1 hour ISIP 796, 1 hour IFP 505, FFP 796, 1 hour FSIP 796, hydrostatic pressure out 1510 psi. Bottom hole temperature 105° F.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations.
