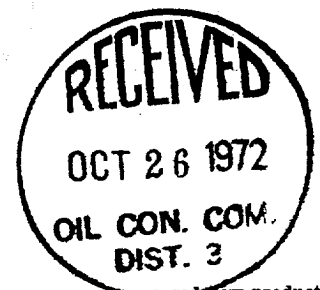

Instructions

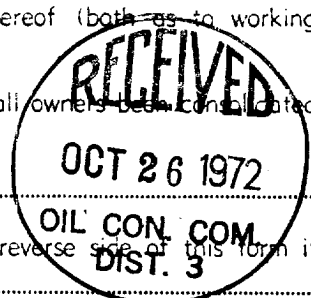

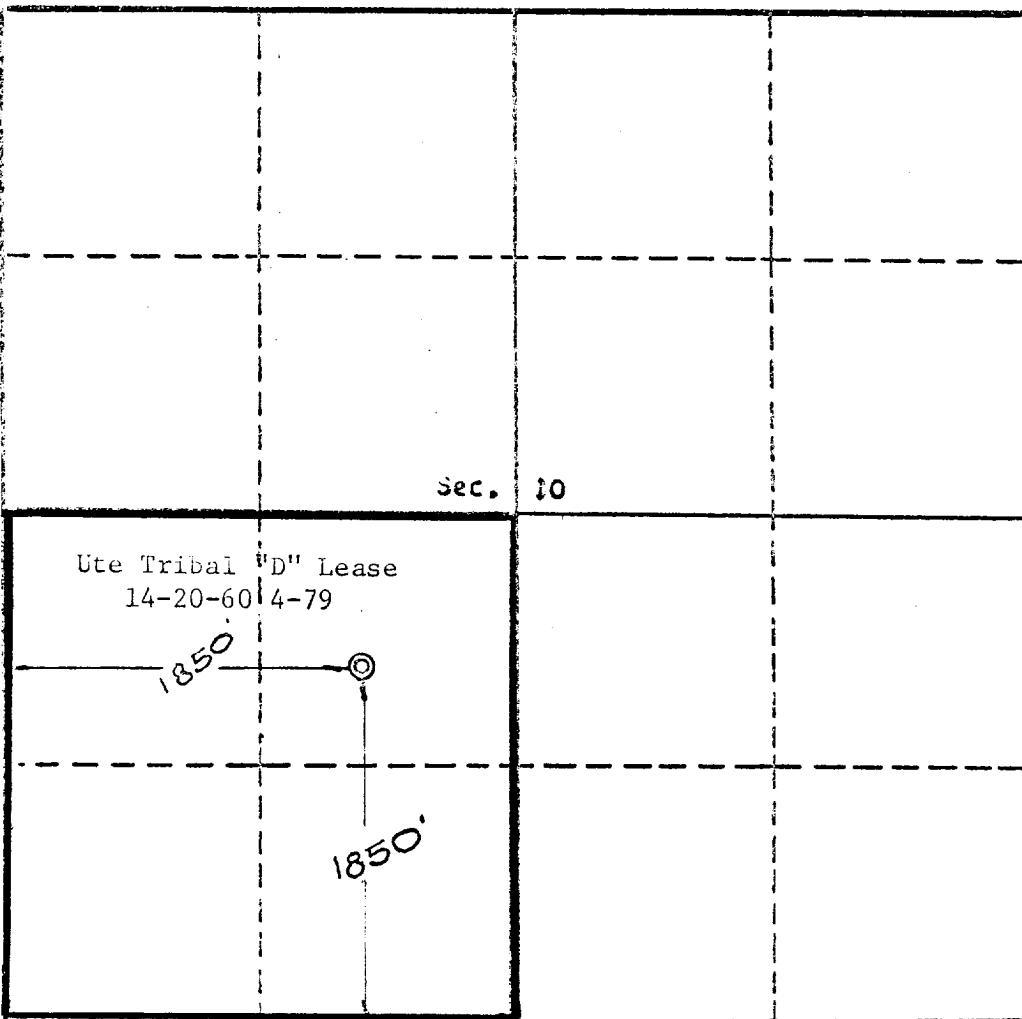
