

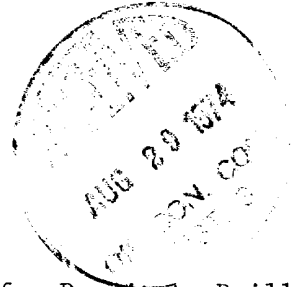

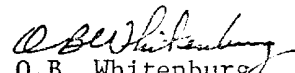

Information regarding existing roads, pipelines, flow line, etc. relative to the above well location are included on the enclosed attachments.

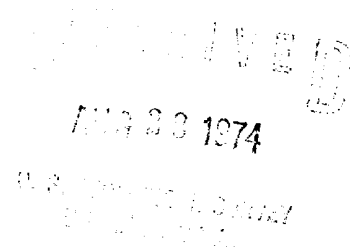

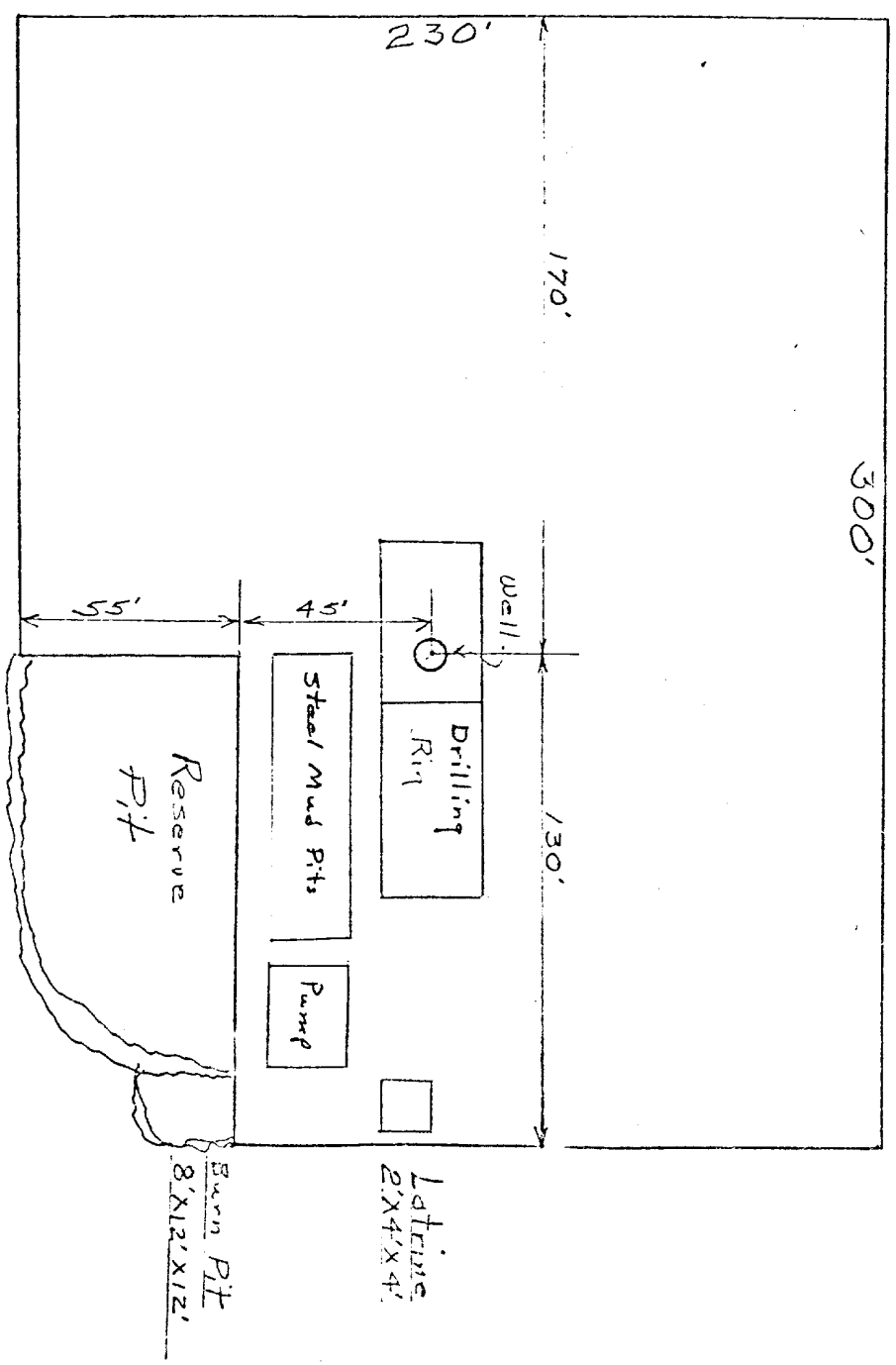

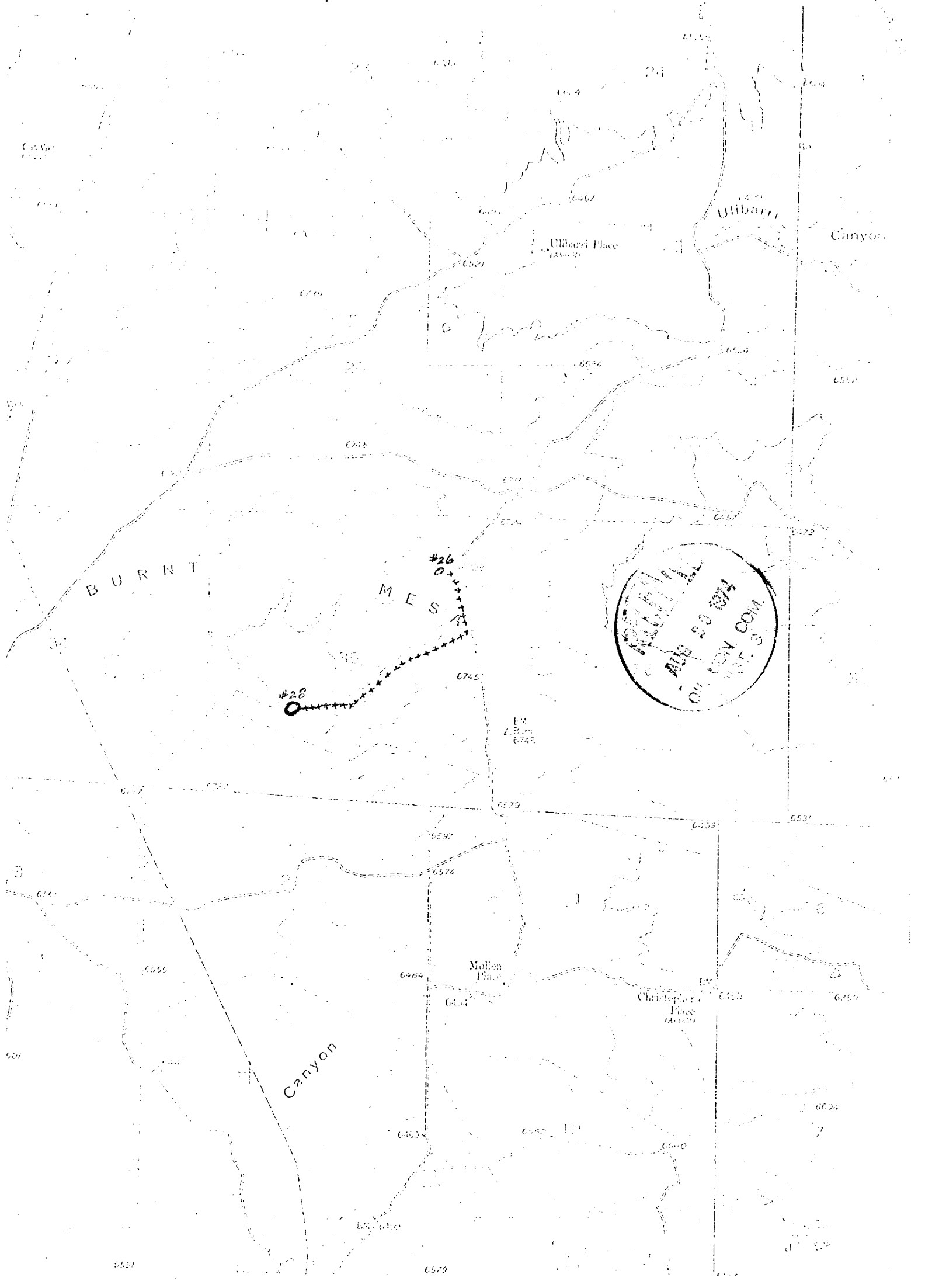


LOCATION AND EQUIPMENT LAYOUT
