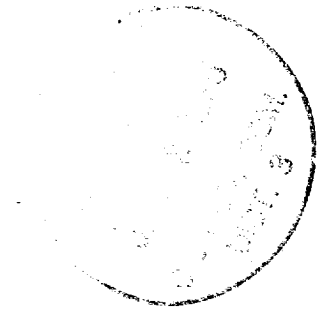


Development Plan for Surface Use
MMI, Clinton Oil, Dow & Marks
Federal Ute 1-36
Verde Gallup Field

Minerals Management Inc. proposes to drill the subject well with rotary tools. A diagram of the proposed location is attached. Established roads will be utilized with improvement required on 0.4 mile of existing road and only 0.2 mile of new road will be necessary. Clearance for road and location will be obtained from the Ute Mountain Tribal Agency, Towaoc, Colorado.

No camps or airstrips will be used or built during drilling of this well. The location falls on rocky soil with only sparse vegetation. Water for drilling will be hauled from the San Juan River. After completion the reserve pit will be backfilled and restored to natural terrain.

The well will be drilled with mud as the drilling fluid. Blowout preventer will be used during drilling.



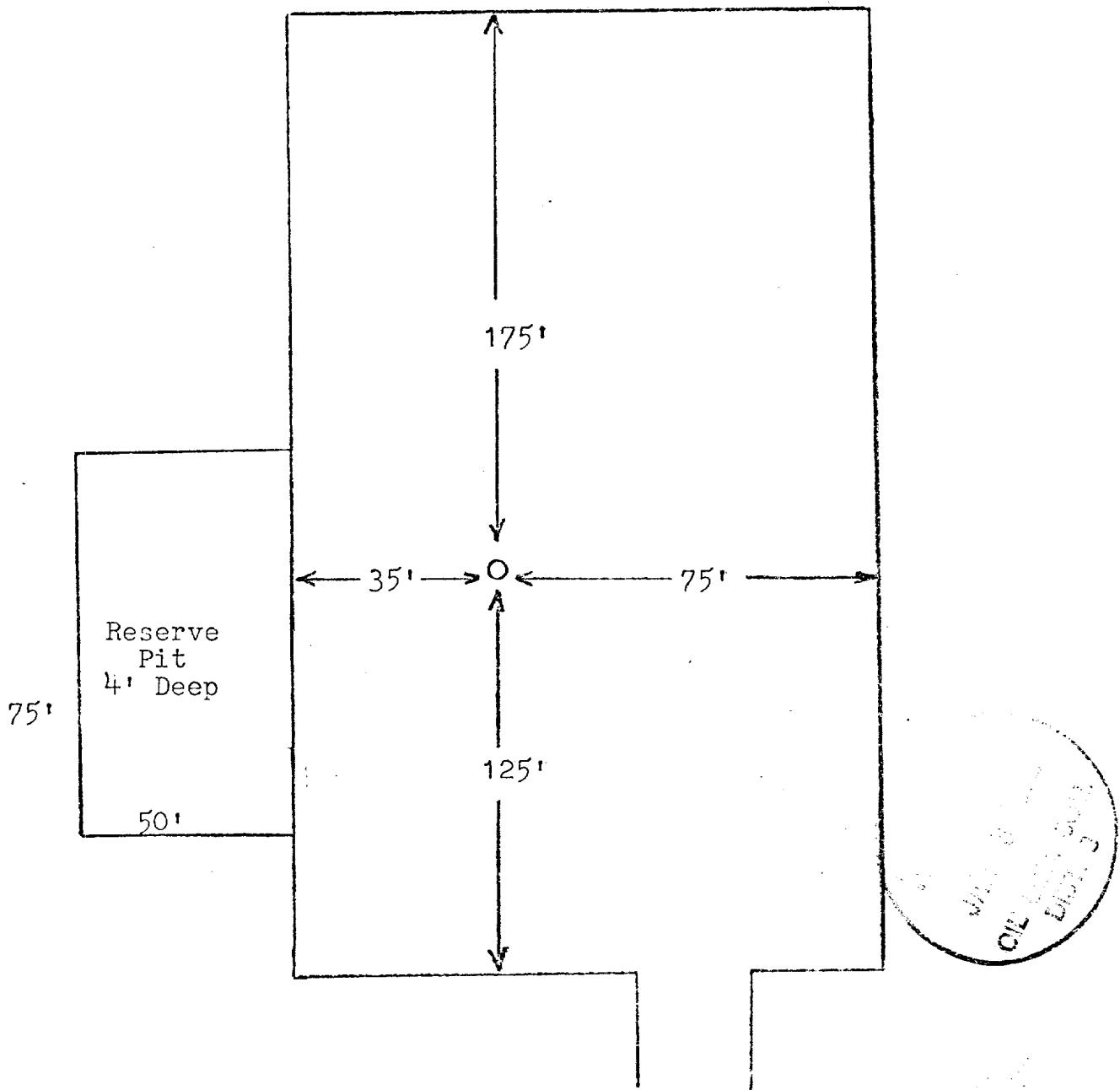
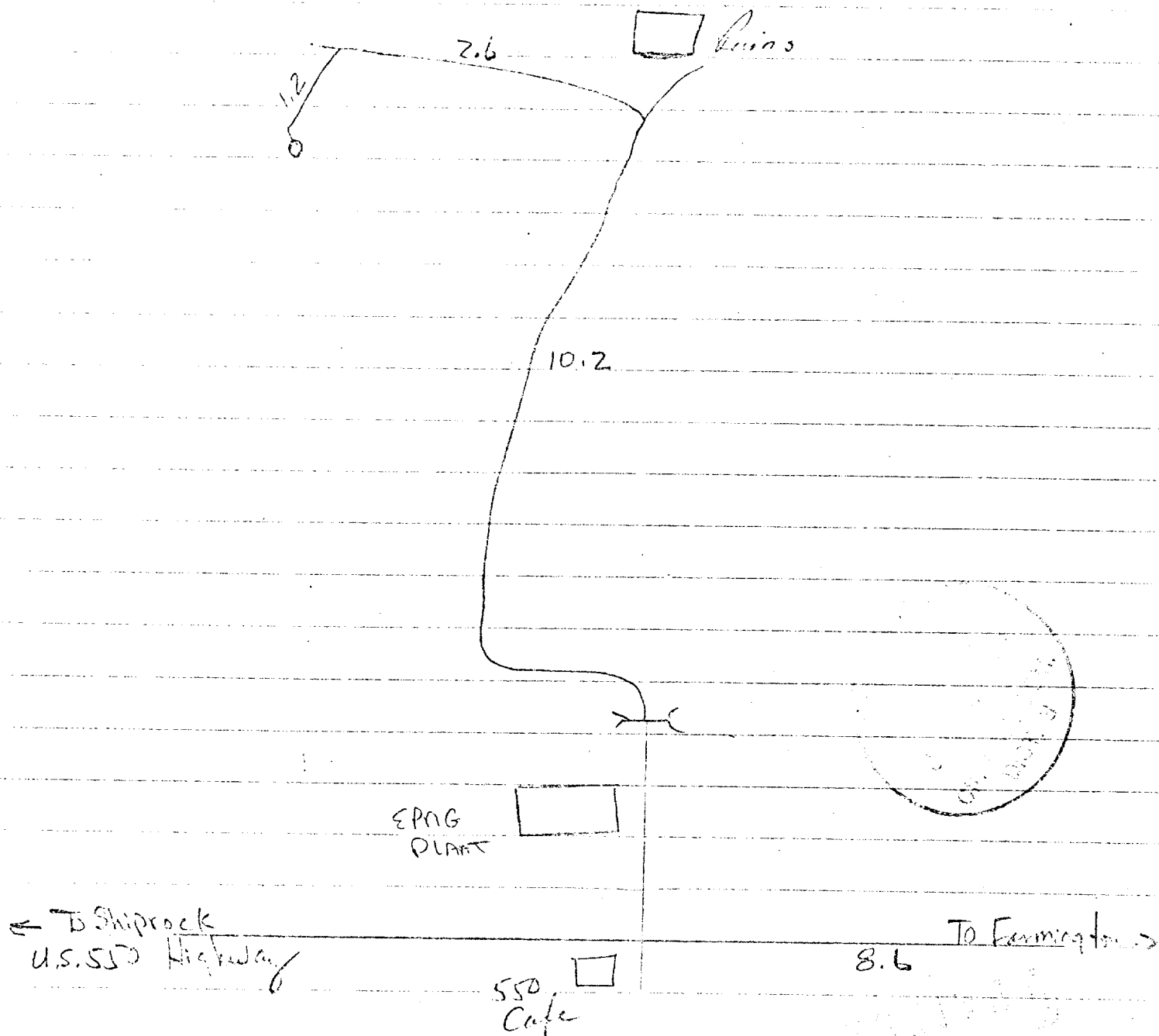


Diagram of Well Location
