A 12-1/4" hole was spudded 2:45 p.m., 5-2-75 and drilled to 205'. The 8-5/8" casing was set at 197' with 175 sacks Class "B" cement with 2X CaCl₂ on 5-2-75. Circulated out 30 sacks and waited on cement to set. Reduced hole size to 7-7/8" and continued drilling to 1618' where the hole size was reduced to 6-3/4". Continued drilling to a total depth of 3100' where on 5-7-75 the 4-1/2" casing was set at 3086' with 700 sacks cement with 50:50 Pozmix, 6% Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack followed with 50 sacks Class "B" Neat. The cement did not circulate.

Instructions
