Also enclosed is location layout showing approximate location of rig, pits and pipe rights.

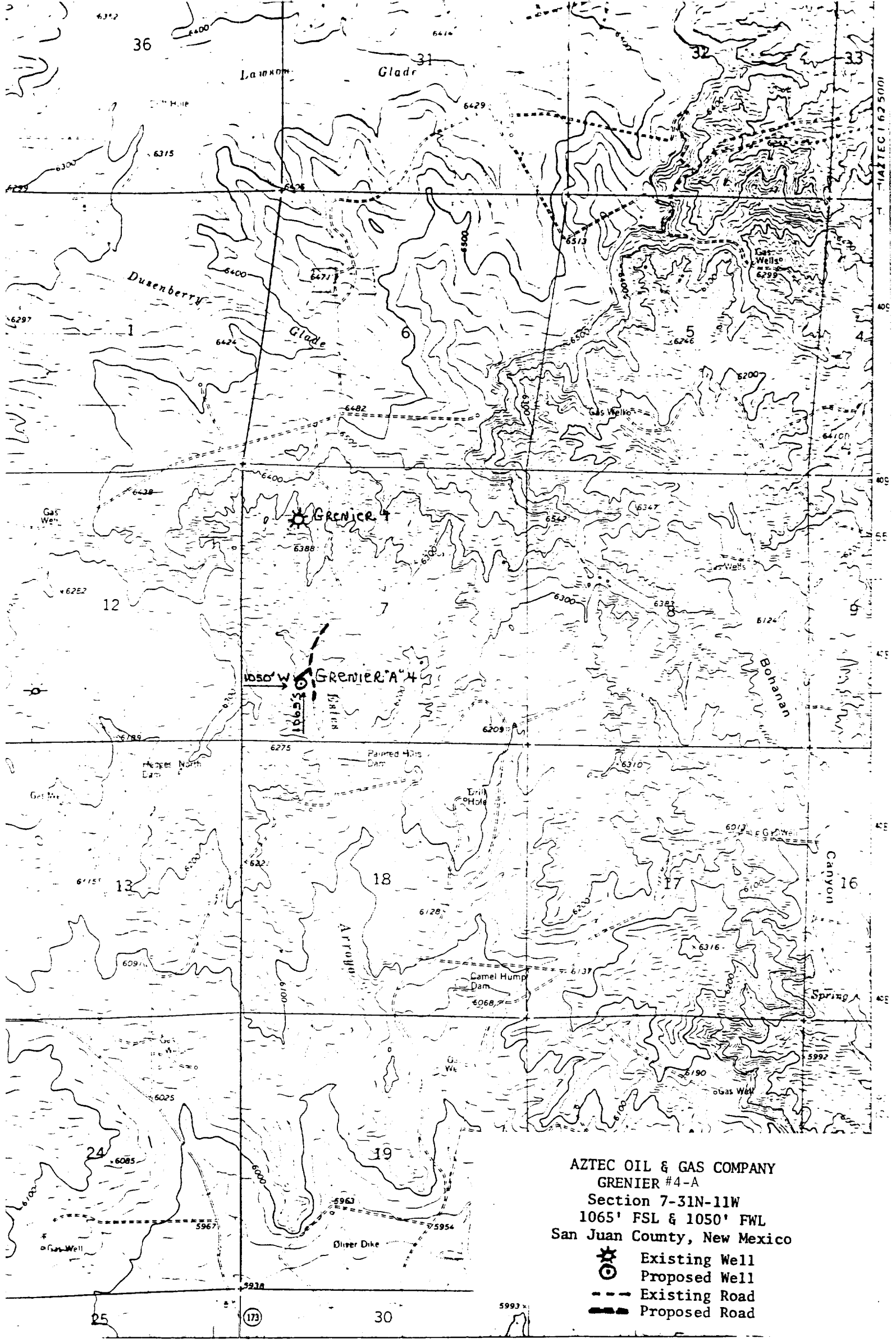
Water supply will be San Juan River.

In the event of a dry hole, location will be graded and reseeded according to Bureau of Land Management standards.



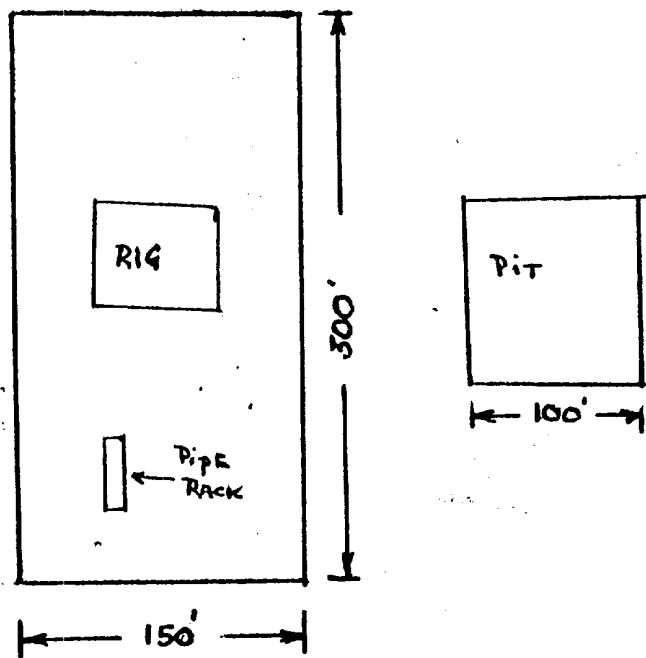

LOCATION LAYOUT

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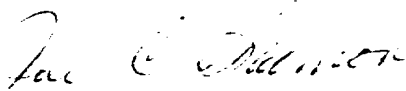
RE: Blowout Preventer Plan

Dear Sir:

All drilling and completion wells will be equipped with 8" Shaffer LWP double hydraulic blowout preventers and a 2000 "C" Payne Hydraulic closing unit with steel line.

The preventer is 3000# working pressure and 6000# test.

All crews will be thoroughly trained in the operation of this preventer. The preventer will be tested at the beginning of every tower change to insure proper operation.
