Spud 12-1/4" hole 2:00 a.m., 9-24-76 and drilled to 268'. Set 9-5/8" casing at 267' with 280 sacks Class "B" cement with 2X CaCl₂ 9-24-76. Circulated good cement. Waited on cement to set, tested casing, blowout preventer and manifold to 800 psi OK and reduced hole to 8-3/4". Drilled to 2875', encountering 1-1/2" water flow at 2663', and set 7" casing at 2875'. Ran 20 gallons CW-7 with 4 gallons fluid loss additive in 20 barrels water ahead of 550 sacks Class "B" cement, containing 6X gel, 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug, followed by 50 sacks Class "B" Neat on 9-28-76. Did not circulate cement. Waited on cement to set and continued drilling to TD 3200' on 10-1-76. Hung 4-1/2" liner from 2653-3193'. Pumped in 20 gallons CW-7 surfactant and 4 gallons fluid loss additive in 20 barrels water. Cemented liner with 190 sacks Class "B" 50:50 Poz, 6X Gel, 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug with 0.2X friction reducer, followed with 75 sacks Class "B" 50:50 Poz, 6X Gel on 10-1-76. Reversed out chemical wash and no cement.

Instructions
