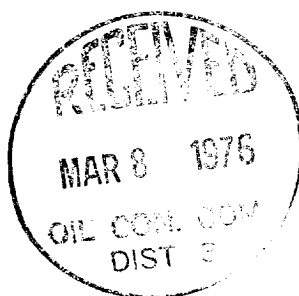

Drilled out from under surface on 12-21-75 and drilled a 6 3/4" hole with air to a depth of 2350 feet, last 10 feet becoming moist with no returns. Converted to mud and drilled on to 2584' driller's T.D. (2594' logger's T.D.). Only show in well was possible very light gas show in top 10 feet of Dakota section. T.D. was reached on 12-24-75 and Schlumberger logs were run on 12-25-75. U.S.G.S. was called and request made for plugging instructions.

Instructions
