The above captioned well was commenced on 12-19-75 and 8 5/8" surface casing set to a depth of 541' from K.B. A 63/4" hole was air drilled from under surface to driller's depth of 2350' then converted to mud and drilled to 2584' driller's T.D. (2594' logger's T.D.). Throughout the entire drilling operation no significant shows of oil or gas were found (only very slight gas show in top of Dakota) and the same non-commercial indications were concluded from logging.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
