A 6 3/4" hole was drilled from under surface on 12-29-75 with air to a depth of 1886 feet. Hole became wet at depth of 1871 and operations were converted to mud drilling at 1886 feet. The 6 3/4" hole was mud drilled on to a total depth of 2570 feet (log depth 2571'). T.L. reached on 1-1-76. Well was logged by Schlumberger on 1-1-76 (IES, Comp. Neut.-Fm On logs).

1-2-76 ran 58 joints of 4 1/2" J-55 10.23# R-3 casing and set this 2540 feet of casing at approx. 2550' B.P. depth and cemented with 75 sacks of 50-50 Pos. cement. Insert float valve set in top of bottom joint or approx. 44 feet above bottom of casing. Plug down at 1:30 PM, 1-2-76.

Instructions
