The above captioned well has been re-entered and drilled to a depth of 2505' and 4 1/2" casing set & cemented through the prospective Dakota horizon. The Dakota sand zones have been perforated & tested; however, no commercial production of gas or oil has been indicated at this time. (See "Well History" and "Completion Report".)

Since the above operations have been performed, the Robert C. Anderson Ute Mtn. Ute No. 4 & No. 5 have recently been drilled in Sec. 14 - Twp. 31N - R16W and 4 1/2" casing set in the upper Dakota section of these wells. Around February 15, 1978 it is planned to move in a completion rig and commence completion of these wells and while the completion rig is here it is planned to move it on the above captioned well (Pickett-N. Horseshoe No. 1) and further test it for commercial use and/or promptly abandon it according to regulations. It is therefore requested that the above well be granted temporary abandonment or suspension of operations for a period of 90 days.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
