Gentlemen:

Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding conditions and an ownership plat for the above captioned Dakota well.

The Mudge A #1E proposed site is 815 FNL, 740 FWL, Section 9, T31N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This places the well only 740 east of the boundary line of the proration unit. This is the only feasible site due to topographical conditions as sketched on the C-102.




