Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding topography and an ownership plat for the above captioned well.


The proposed site of the Childers #1 has been relocated from 2060 FNL, 840 FWL at the request of the Bureau of Land Management. The original location would have required a lengthy, difficult to construct and maintain access road into an otherwise undisturbed canyon. Placement of the location on the mesa top at the head of this canyon was requested. Due to existing facilities and topography, the best place to locate this well is 420 FNL, 1660 FWL. This places the well only 420 feet from the northern section boundary.

A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a waiver of objection.

Pursuant to authority of Rule 104-F we respectfully request your approval of an exemption to the standard well location requirements.
