Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to your application dated April 4, 1995 on behalf of the operator, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde infill gas well location on an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising the E/2 of Section 33, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Said GPU is currently dedicated to the Rosa Unit Well No. 90 (API No. 30-045-25370) located at a standard gas well location 1800 feet from the North line and 1810 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 33.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at he following unorthodox infill gas well location is hereby approved:

Rosa Unit Well No. 1904 2435'FSL - 2340'FEL ('Init J')

Further, Northwest Pipeline Corporation is hereby authorized to dedicate Blanco-Mesaverde gas production on the subject GPU from both the Rosa Unit Well Nos. 90 and 90A.

Said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to the prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico.
