- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

is hereby authorized to complete its located in Unit of Section of Township 39 North, Range 10 wint, NMPM, See Journal County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Mormonand formations at approximately 7550 feet through 4/3 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 7550 feet.

## IT IT FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

The operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.

Prior to commencing injection operations into the well, the casing shall be pressure from the surface to the packer setting depth to assure the integrity of said casing.
