## 13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Meridian Oil Inc. requests an extension to June 1, 1996 of the original Sundry Notice for the subject well. The original approved Sundry requested a shut-in for the subject well due to high water volumes and low gas volumes resulting in this well being non-economical to produce. This well is currently being evaluated for the possibility of the following work to decrease the water production and increase the gas production: pump installation and/or pull existing 2 3/8" tubing. Clean out wellbore until formation stabilizes. Run a 4 1/2" liner and rerun 2 3/8" tubing, return the well to production.
