13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to workover this well to install a 5 1/2" liner in the openhole. The liner will overlap inside the 7" intermediate casing by a minimum of 40'. A 2 3/8" tubing string configured for a downhole pump will be set approximately 5' above PBTD. The downhole pump assembly will be run on a 3/4" sucker rod string to facilitate water removal from the wellbore and restoration of gas production.
