

This is a request for administrative approval for a non-standard proration unit for a gas well location in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool.

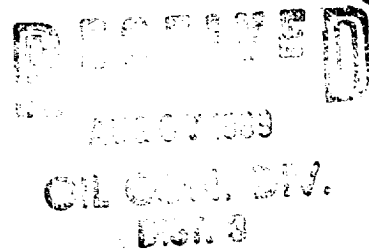

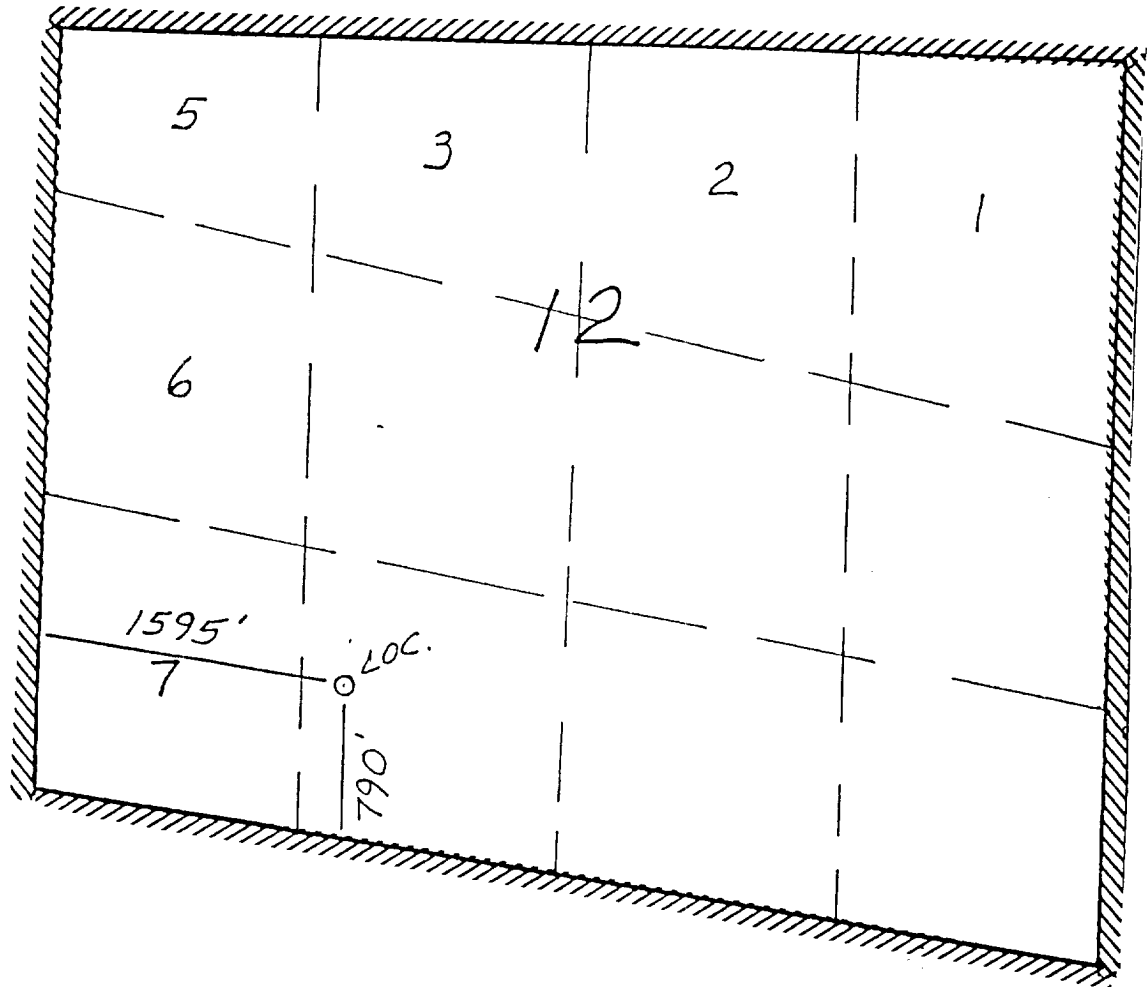
