During the recavitation of the subject well, Burlington Resources was unable to pull the existing 5 1/2" liner. It is intended to sidetrack the well in the following manner:

Set a cast iron bridge plug above the 5 1/2" liner hanger at 2968'. Mill a window at 2956-2964'. Drill to total depth at 3253'. The well will then be recavitated as intended in the sundry approved 7-29-97.
