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This well has been shut for the last 9 months or so. Last summer we turned on well after shut in due to ROW dispute and the gas volumes had dropped significantly so we shut well back in until we had a chance to clean out well. 23# 7" casing is set at 3042' KB with open hole of 3073' - 3495' KB. KB=10' 0". TD = 3495' KB

We plan on cleaning out well with an Air Package to TD of 3495' KB. To clean out with air we will need to construct a water pit 40' X 50" X 10' deep (lined with at least 8 mil plastic) and a blow pit (unlined so as to flare gas) which will drain to lined water pit. Pits will be fenced until closure of pits. After clean out is complete and all fluids removed, we will cover all coal fines within the plastic by folding in sides and bury. Soil will be reclaimed and reseeded to BLM specs. All proposed work will be on existing ROW (disturbed well pad).

We also plan on running a 17# 5/12" liner through open hole with a retrievable liner hanger in 23# 7" casing and set at approximately 2990' KB. 5 1/2" liner will be pre drilled, tapped, and plugged with aluminum drillable plugs. We plan on lowering tubing into 5 1/2" liner to help lower water level in well bore.

Proposed work is planned to begin May 1, 1995 after approval of Sundry Notice.
