

Dear Mr. Hulse:

Reference is made to your application dated November 5, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your and the standard coal gas to be located 870 feet from the South line and 2008 feet from the West line (South line and 2008). NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
