7-22-95 Move on location and rig up. Spud surface hole at 1830 hrs 7/21/95. TD surface hole at 285'. TOH. Ran 6 jts. (270.52') of 9-5/8", 36#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed at 282' KB. Cemented with 150 sx. (177 cu.ft.) of CI "B" with 3% CaCl2 and 1/4# celloflake/sk. Displaced plug with 20 bbls of water. Plug down at 0300 hrs. 7/22/95. Circulated out 6 bbls cement to surface.

7-23-95 Pressure test to 1500#-held OK.

7-26-95 TD'd intermediate hole at 3640' with mud and bit #4 (8-3/4", HTC, J22).

7-27-95 Ran 82 jts (3652.34') of 7", 20#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed at 3644.54' KB. Float collar at 3621'. BJ cemented with 410 sx (841 cu.ft.) of class "B" 65/35 poz with 2% CaCl2, 8% gel, and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Tailed with 200 sx (240 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 2% CaCl2 and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Preceded cement with 30 bbls of water and 10 bbls of scavenger cement. Displaced cement with 146 bbls of water and plug down at 1900 hrs 7-26-95. Circulate 17 bbls of cement to surface. Pressure test BOP and casing to 1500# - held OK.

7-28-95 Unload well with N2. Well dusting @ 1000 hrs 7-27-95.

7-29-95 TD'd well at 6060' with gas and bit #5 (6-1/4", HTC, J-33).

7-30-95 Schlumberger ran IND/GR, CDL/SNL and temp logs. Ran 59 jts (2550.10') of 4-1/2", 10.5#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed at 6060' KB. Float collar at 6037'. Marker joint at 5400' KB. Top of liner hanger at 3510'. BJ preceded cement with 210 bbls of gel water, 5 bbls of water and 10 bbls of scavenger cement. Cement with 240 sx (415 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 4% gel and 0.5% CF14 (fluid loss). Displaced cement with 66 bbls of water and plug down @ 2000 hrs 7-29-95. Reversed out 12 bbls of cement. Rig released at 0300 hrs 6-30-95.
