Sand oil free the Gallup formation in open hole.

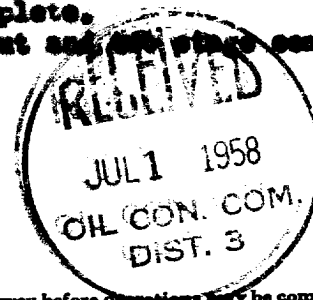
13-3/8" O.D. @ 120' w/100 sz. regular cement, circulated to surface.

5 1/2" O.D. 1 1/2", @ 3700', set D.V. Tool below point lockout and 100' stage cement with 25 sz. below and 100 sz. above tool.
