DETAILS OF WORK

Plan to drill with rotary tools to estimated depth of 3680' or to the top of the Gallup formation. Drill pay section with cable tools, to approximate depth of 3830 feet and to sand oil fracs the Gallup formation in open hole.

Casing Program: 8-5/8" O.D. at 110 feet cemented to surface.
5-1/2" O.D. at 3680 feet. Set D.V. tool below Point Lookout and two stage cement w/25 sx. below and 100 sx. above tool.

The NW NE of Section 30 is dedicated to this well.
