DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to total depth of 1255', with 7 5/8" csg. set at 70' with 30 sacks cement circulated, 4 1/2" csg. set at 1242' with 175 sacks. Casing was perforated 1137-1145 with 4 shots per foot. Sand frac with 16,680 gal. oil and 30,000# sand, maximum pressure 1450# minimum pressure 1200#, injection rate 24 BPM. Flushed with 1000 gal. Swabbed 100 H2O 32 hrs. Put on pump, pumped 11 H2O 24 hrs. Pulled rods. Swabbed with no recovery. Well now idle pending disposition.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
