The enclosed graph of relative pressures of subject test indicates that the build-up rate of the Dakota formation may have suffered interference during the Mesaverde flow period.

Please re-schedule the first half of the packer-leakage test to be submitted as supplemental information to the report received in this office February 18, 1963. (Both zones to be shut in for one week, then flow the Mesaverde for one week while the Dakota formation remains shut in.
