Gentlemen:


On October 27, 1981, this office received your Sundry Notice requesting approval to convert well No. 7 Navajo M located in sec. 34, T. 32 N., R. 17 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, on Navajo Tribal lease 14-20-603-5013 to an injection well. Our letter of November 13, 1981, requested that you submit all items outlined in part II of NTL-2B to this office before approval of your request could be granted. On November 16, 1981, we received your Sundry Notice of subsequent report indicating that conversion of No. 7 Navajo M to an injection well had been completed on November 2, 1981.

Pursuant to 30 CFR 221.54(d) you are hereby assessed twenty five dollars (\$25.00) liquidated damages for failure to obtain approval to convert No. 7 Navajo M to an injection well.

You are also ordered to shut-in No. 7 Navajo M until such time as you submit all items outlined in part II of NTL-2B to this office and obtain approval of your sundry notice to convert No. 7 Navajo M to an injection well.

Procedures governing appeals from final decisions and orders by Conservation Division officials are contained in the regulations in 30 CFR Part 290. A notice of appeal must be filed in this office within 30 days of receipt of the final decision or order being appealed.
