Dear Mr. Arnold:

Subject well has recently been completed as a dual Dakota-Mesa Verde gas producer. A Baker model "D" production packer has been set between zones. The Dakota will be served by 2" tubing and the Mesa Verde by a 1 1/4" annular string. We will be currently submitting the necessary data to obtain administrative approval for this dual completion. In the meantime, this letter will serve to inform you that packer leakage test will be performed by flowing the Dakota on February 16th and the Mesa Verde on February 23rd.

There are no offset operators of interest since we offset the well on three sides. We are not aware of who may be the owner of the undeveloped acreage to the West and North. We do, however, believe that Southern Union Gas Company may hold acreage in the general vicinity of this well and accordingly are notifying them of these tests by copy of this letter.
