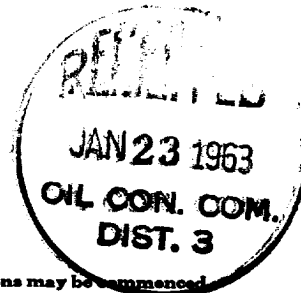
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is **5916** ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

Spotted 30 sq root cement on top of fish at TD of 1715' and cemented 8-5/8" surface casing with 5 sq regular and welded flat metal plate flush with the ground. This abandoned hole is 44' N 60° E of the twin, 3-27-X Navajo, in which 5" has been set, cemented, perforated, frac'd and pump installed.
